I do hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever release and fully discharge the Community Fire Protection District, its officers, employees, medical consultants, hospitals, servants or agents from any and all liability in the premise, and agree to save them harmless.

I hereby voluntarily acknowledge and state that I have been advised regarding my child's present physical condition. I hereby affirm that I am the child's true and legal guardian, and I hereby voluntarily refuse on behalf of my child that my child receive or accept such medical care and/or transportation as recommended by representatives of the Community Fire Protection District; and I do hereby for myself and my child, our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever release and fully discharge the Community Fire Protection District, its officers, employees, medical consultants, hospitals, servants or agents from any and all liability in the premise, and agree to save them harmless.

I hereby voluntarily acknowledge and state that I have been offered transport to one of the hospitals serviced by the Community Fire Protection District. However, I, by my choice or on recommendation of my personal physician, wish transport to _____ hospital. And at my own expense, I have retained _____ ambulance company to transport me. Keep your wound clean and dry. If you have not had a tetanus shot in the last five years call your doctor or clinic to get one. Watch for signs of infection (increasing pain, swelling, redness, or puss drainage) should you find any of these symptoms call your doctor immediately.

You were treated for low blood sugar, this was emergent treatment only. You must eat or your blood sugar level will fall again. Although we recommend you be seen in the emergency department, you must keep your doctor advised of problems such as this episode.

You have elected to have family take you to the hospital, although we recommend against this, you should: Leave now, do not delay transport but go directly to Emergency Department. Follow posted speed limits. Use your seat belts. If you have a problem stop and call 911 for help.

Falling can be a sign of underlying medical problems, notify your doctor of all falls that he or she might identify any problems. Ice and elevation are recommended for 24 hours to limit swelling. The only way to rule out a fracture is to do an x-ray.

There has been controversy about the matter of Mayor Purzner trying to suspend the Chief of Police. It should have come as no surprise to anyone who had read her campaign literature. There are reasons this man needs to be terminated.

There is much you don't know about what has been going on in our police department, unfortunately much of it is ugly and most residents would be outraged by the deplorable actions of the Chief.

When I and several other councilmen inquired about what was going on we were told by then Mayor Dody "you are better off not knowing". We are your representatives and we are accountable to you for using City funds properly. As you might suspect this immediately raised questions about what was going on in this department. Especially since this dramatically impacted our budget and the ability to maintain the services the City provided.

The situation became so bad it affected the moral of the police officers and eventually the union interceded and conducted a survey that showed 95% of the officers had no confidence in the Chief. ↑

Unfortunately there were even more serious problems that developed which caused huge outlays of your money to defend. Notable was the completely repulsive incident that was reported in the River Front Times and unfortunately was backed up by a huge amount of evidence regarding Sylcox, Alves et al. After that the City was embroiled in the wrongful death of a Hispanic gentleman named Dominguez Esteban Silva. When I recently confronted the Chief about his denying Mr. Silva medical attention he claimed my accusation was false, please see **Exhibit "A"** on the reverse side that I received from the state investigator that shows **the man was denied medical treatment.**

Why wasn't this information turned over to the press? It was, I did it personally however the city attorney Rob Herman has so many connections in the news media they wouldn't print anything.

This Chief has caused litigation which has cost the City over a million dollars, Mayor Purzner was completely justified in her actions of suspending the Chief.

Officers vote no confidence in police chief

Union seeks meeting with Overland

Concerns surrounding the leadership of the Overland Police Department have prompted a request for a meeting between Overland elected officials and members of the

Missouri Union of Law Enforcement Local 57.

The request follows a vote of no confidence in the city's Police Chief James Herron by a majority of the city's officers in a union survey.

"They (the officers) believe the problem stems from one indi-

vidual, and something has to be done dealing with that individual," Craven said.

Herron refused to comment on the matter. Overland Mayor Bob Dody could not be reached for comment.
